- deterrence in contemporary statecraft and warfare
- political warfare and how we operate in the 'grey zone'
- Australia's future defence strategy and operational concepts
- emerging technologies including information security, artificial intelligence and automation
- strategic lessons learnt from and future defence and security implications of domestic and regional disaster relief operations.

Submitting your manuscript

AJDSS considers:

- scholarly research papers of 4000 to 6000 words excluding footnotes, tables and figures (peer reviewed)
- commentary and opinion essays of 1500 to 4000 words
- reviews and review essays (generally by commission) of 800 to 2500 words
- correspondence in response to articles in past issues (up to 2000 words).

Academic articles undergo a double-blind peer review process. This process can be lengthy (up to 12 weeks); and reviews may recommend revision and resubmission.

Submissions of commentary, reviews and correspondence are assessed by the editorial office and editorial review board; every effort is made to provide responses within 8–12 weeks from submission.

We strongly recommend reviewing the editorial guidelines and submission information provided on our website before submitting your article.
