 - (vi) for a foreign firm or company, details of its registration, incorporation and place of business in Australia and the name of any Australian representative and its ABN (Australian Business Number) / ARBN (Australian Registered Body Number) (if any); and
 - (vii) if an Australian company, its ACN (Australian Company Number) / ARBN and ABN as applicable.
