



Factsheet: Leeuwin Barracks, Western Australia

Leeuwin Barracks (the site) is a 14.30 hectare naval base that is currently classified as surplus to Defence capability requirements.

In 2021, Defence suspended the divestment process for Leeuwin Barracks in order to conduct a study on its long term estate requirements in the Perth and Fremantle region.

A number of essential personnel and operational elements retain use of the site while Defence's broader strategic studies are under consideration which includes the Defence Strategic Review.

Defence has informed the Town of East Fremantle as well as the Western Australian Government regarding the decision to suspend the divestment of the site.

The site is located at Riverside Road in East Fremantle, Western Australia (WA), 6158 and is outlined in red in the below map.



The Navy Cadet (Training Ship Perth) and Preston Point facilities, near Leeuwin Barracks (also outlined in red), are enduring and will not form part of the Leeuwin Barracks divestment.
