"As Cost Analyst, I collect and analyse historical and raw data to explore cost relationships and support the development of cost estimates.


I support the development of better-informed cost estimates and business cases for senior Defence decision-makers.

# My responsibilities

#### In my day-to-day activities I may:

- 1. Assist in curating and normalising data and information for use in data analysis.
- 2. Undertake data analytics to establish relationships between capability variables.
- 3. Analyse patterns in risk and contingency realisation for capability projects.
- 4. Estimate and review the Total Cost of Ownership of capability to inform decision-makers and for future capabilities.
- 5. Review historic data to identify gaps and opportunities in data structures and practices.
- 6. Analyst cost estimates and provide advice to senior management to support the decision-making process.
- 7. Develop indicative cost estimates using high level models to assess the impact of trade off proposals.
- 8. Review policy, processes, methods, tools and training to provide feedback and suggestions.
- 9. Communicate with team members and key stakeholders in the development and analysis of cost estimates.

- 1. Communication and interpersonal relationship skills to engage and build trust with multiple stakeholders.
- 2. Data and analytics ability to undertake technical and complex data analytics to produce insights.
- 3. Mentoring to build data literacy and technical skills in my area and across the broader cost professional community.

- 5. Defence knowledge and networking to understand the broader needs, processes, business and priorities of the capability community to guide data analytics.


