ADF Member and Family Transition Seminar Information for Stallholders

ADF Member and Family Transition Seminars (Seminar) are one-day events that include presentations about the transition process, an exhibition hall, and panel discussions featuring experts and previously transitioned members.

Defence encourages all ADF members, their families and/or loved ones, to attend a Seminar at regular intervals through their career.

Seminar management is conducted by a National team in consultation with local Transition Centres to ensure local organisations and providers have the opportunity to participate.

STALLHOLDERS AT ADF MEMBER AND FAMILY TRANSITION SEMINARS

The purpose of ADF Member and Family Transition Seminars is to provide ADF members and their families with information to help them in making the decision to transition or not, or to help them prepare for their transition where they have already made the decision.

The focus of Seminars is the Commonwealth supports provided to members by the Department of Defence (Defence), the Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA) and the Commonwealth Superannuation Corporation (CSC) which are foundational to positive transition outcomes.

Seminars include an Exhibition Hall with representatives from Defence, DVA and CSC, not-for-profit Ex-Service Organisations (ESOs) and State and Territory Governments (e.g. Emergency Services) providing information to assist transition planning.

Venue capacity and resourcing constraints impose limitations on the number of stallholders that can be accommodated at any given Seminar.

It is Defence practice that for-profit entities are not permitted to hold stalls at Seminars in order to ensure there is no perception of a commercial advantage to these entities, over their competitors.

Eligible and Ineligible ADF Member and Family Transition Seminar stallholders are as follows:

Eligible:

- Not-for-profit Ex-Service Organisations (ESOs)
- Not-for-profit charities
- · Not-for-profit education providers
- · Commonwealth, State and Territory Governments and Government organisations
- Suppliers currently contracted to Defence for the purposes of the Seminar
- For-profit entities affiliated with the Veteran Employment Program.

Not Eligible

- · For-profit ESOs
- · For-profit education providers
- · Private sector employers.

Where a for-profit entity is offering a not-for-profit product or service, an application to become a stallholder is assessed on a case-by-case basis subject to venue capacity.
