

# Project Management Information

**Project management qualifications are available for Defence members with valid project management experience.**

Defence has a myriad of projects underway at any given time. Personnel involved with these projects may gain applicable project management experience, which can be validated and used as a pathway towards a nationally accredited project management qualification.

Defence has contracted an external registered training organisation with project management expertise to provide assessment and qualification issuance for:

## **BSB40920 Certificate IV in Project Management Practice**

## **BSB50820 Diploma of Project Management**

Project Management qualifications reflect the role of individuals who apply project management skills and knowledge in a variety of contexts, across a number of industry sectors. Defence project experience reflects Defence's specific context and processes, which may limit the candidate's evidence availability, the required number of project iterations, and the required leadership component of managing projects.

If the candidate's experience, skills, or evidence is insufficient, then a partial qualification may be issued with additional training to build project management skills in order to gain the qualification.

RPL towards project management will require an extra enrolment form; a third party report from the candidate's supervisor; technical terms knowledge quiz; and a competency conversation with an assessor to address any evidence gaps.

Suitable for members of a project team with recent experience in supporting wider project operations in at least one project, but no direct responsibility for overall project outcomes.

BSBPMG533 Manage project cost

BSBPMG534 Manage project human resources
