#### 1 Name

This instrument is the Determination under the Australian Operational Service Medal Regulation 2012 (Special Operations) 2019.

#### 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after signature.

#### **3** Authority

This instrument is made under regulation 12 of the Australian Operational Service Medal Regulation 2012.

### 4 Ribbon and form of the accumulated service device for the Australian Operational Service Medal (Special Operations)

For section 12 of the Regulation, both of the following apply.

- (a) The ribbon denoting Special Operations is 32 millimetres wide and has a central red stripe, flanked by black stripes of equal width.
- (b) The accumulated service device for Special Operations is in the form of an Arabic numeral of antique-silver finish 8 millimetres high (width to match in proportion to the specific number).
