- 3. Service may be aggregated over a period of 2 years to achieve an average total of at least 12 days per annum, ie a total of at least 24 days service within a 2 year period
- 4. Up to 3 years qualifying service as a commissioned officer of the Permanent Force may be counted toward the award of the Medal only.
- 5. Up to 3 years qualifying service as a member of the Permanent Force may be counted toward the award of the Medal only.
