ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God Queen of Australia and Her other Realms and Territories, Head of the Commonwealth:

TO ALL to whom these Presents shall come,

GREETING:

WHEREAS by Letters Patent dated 26 May 1998 given under the Great Seal of Australia, we instituted an Australian medal, designated and styled the Defence Long Service Medal for the purpose of according recognition to persons who render long and efficient service as members of the Defence Force and to certain other persons who render long and efficient service in association with the Defence Force:

AND WHEREAS the Letters Patent ordained the award of a medal so instituted be governed by the Defence Long Service Medal Regulations set out in the Schedule to the Letters Patent:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that certain amendments of the Regulations be made:

KNOW YOU that We do, by these Presents, declare Our pleasure that the Letters Patent dated 26 May 1998, as amended by Letters Patent dated 3 March 2000, be further amended, but without prejudice to anything lawfully done thereunder, as set out in the Schedule, with effect from 26 May 1998.

# Amendment of the Defence Long Service Medal Regulations

### 1 Subregulation 3 (1)

### substitute

- (1) The Medal may be awarded to a member, or former member, of the Defence Force (the *member*) who:
  - (a) has given:
    - (i) qualifying service for a period of at least 15 years or periods that, in total, amount to at least 15 years; and
    - (ii) at least 1 day's qualifying service on or after 20 April 1994; or
  - (b) has given:
    - (i) qualifying service for a period of at least 15 years or periods that, in total amount to at least 15 years; and
    - (ii) at least 1 day's qualifying service on or after 14 February 1975; and
    - (iii) all of the qualifying service before 20 April 1994; and
    - (iv) qualifying service, none of which can be recognised for the Defence Force Service Awards Regulations, either by reason of its length or its character.
