

After Action Report Epic 2
Clearance of TIZAK STH
11 June 2010

Mission: Epic Tp was to conduct a Capture/ Kill mission on Obj Tortair, who was located IVO compound SK2879 in the Southern Tizak region of Shah Wali Khot.

Epic2 was part of the [redacted] s33(a)(ii) on Token 2 along with Epic 5. Upon insertion into Manta 8 (IVO GR 42S TA 3226 5780;190 m South of SK2879) Token 2 and ground Call signs received SAF from the North and East of the HLZ location.

Epic 1 was located on Token 1 providing AFS for the assault and after [redacted] s33(a)(ii)

Epic 2 engaged groups of 2-4 personnel moving in and around the SK2880 and SK2883 COI's through out the next hour resulting in several unconfirmed and one confirmed EKIA along with a PKM gunner engaged to the North East of Epic 2's location by Epic 22 and 23. Epic 2 also [redacted] s33(a)(ii)

**Note: During the total course of the clearance both ground assault and
overwatch call signs sustained fire of various intensity, from unidentified INS
positions originating from the high ground to the North, South and East of the
target location.**
