1 Name

This instrument is the *Australian Service Medal (Declared Operation) Amendment 2023*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences the day after signature.

3 Authority

This instrument is made under regulation 3 of the *Australian Service Medal Regulations*.

4 Savings

If a person was awarded a medal before the commencement of this Determination under an instrument amended or repealed by Schedules 1 to 18 of this Determination, the award of the medal is not affected by the repeal of the instrument.
