



Access Types

There are two types of access to the AUKUS licence-free environment you can apply for:

1. **'Partial' Access:** exemptions to Australia's export control laws
2. **'Full' Access:** exemptions to Australia's export control laws + additional exemptions to US law under ITAR §126.7

Note: Persons/entities certified as **Australian Authorized Users** will already be registered as **AUKUS Authorised Users** and be able to access Australian exemptions.
