

(My Australian Defence Exports)




Types of Applications in MADE

Permits

- ♠ Export or supply controlled items: Apply to export or supply goods and technology listed on the Defence and Strategic Goods List (DSGL).
- → 10A: Apply to supply DSGL-listed technology to non-exempt foreign persons within Australia.
- → 10B: Apply to further transfer outside Australia - certain DSGL-listed goods and technology that were previously transfered from Australia.
- 10C: Apply to provide services related to certain DSGL-listed goods and technology outside Australia.

Use the MADE Application Portal to:



- Manage Data: Keep your organisation's information and contact details up to date.
- **Update Your Profile:** Regularly check and update your profile information.
- Manage Contacts: Add or remove authorised contacts as needed.
- **Track Applications:** Monitor the progress and status of your applications.

Certificates

- International Import Certificate: Certify that imported goods will be used as stated and not reexported without permission.
- Non-Transfer and End-Use Certificate: Certify that the goods will not be transferred to another party and will be used as specified.
- Delivery Verification Certificate: Obtain a certificate verifying that the exported goods have been delivered to the intended destination.

Assessments and Registrations

- DSGL / Activity Assessment: Evaluate whether your activities or items fall under DSGL controls.
- Brokering Arrangement: Apply for permission to arrange the supply of DSGL-listed items between two foreign entities.
- Broker Registration: Register as a broker to legally arrange the supply of DSGL-listed items.
