

#### **Getting Here:**

The Abel Smith Lecture Theatre (Building 23) is highlighted below and can be found in the attached map.



Parking at The University of Queensland is usually in high demand. If able, it is recommended to use public transport, Uber or carpool if parking on-site. The City Cat from the CBD is convenient and drops off at the ferry terminal just east of the Theatre. It is also a lovely way to experience Brisbane.

If you do park at UQ, the blue parking zones are casual per hour parking at \$1.50/hour, up to \$6.50 max/day. The grey parking areas are \$2.50/hour, up to \$9.10 max/day and red parking zones \$3.25/hour, up to \$25 max/day.

The blue ring road or grey zones underneath Playing Fields 4 and 5 will be the closest parking locations to the Theatre.

Please allow adequate time for parking or public transport prior to the start of the Symposium.
