STATEMENT OF REASONS UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 1982

1. I refer to the request by (the applicant), dated and received on 1 October 2024 by the Department of Defence (Defence), for access to the following documents under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (Cth) (FOI Act):

"Under foi, I request the following:

The number of members, classified as other ranks, who transferred to ADFA to undertake university education between 2012 to present."

2. I am the authorised officer pursuant to section 23 of the FOI Act to make a decision on this FOI request.

Documents identified

- 3. I have identified no documents as falling within the scope of the request.
- 4. One document was generated under section 17 of the FOI Act matching the description of this request. In accordance with section 17 of the FOI Act:
 - a. written document was produced containing the information by using a 'computer or other equipment that is ordinarily available to the agency for retrieving or collating stored information' (section 12(1)(c)(i)); and
 - b. producing the written document did not substantially and unreasonably divert the resources of the agency from its other operations (section 17(2)).
