ACG HORNET DISPLAY PILOT WORK-UP – ^{\$47E(c)}

s47E(c)s2220CU instructor, has been selected as ACG's F/A-18Aerobatic Display Pilot from January 2015.

2. This minute details the 2OCU-proposed 81WG Aerobatic Display Pilot TMP in preparation for the 2015 Australian International Airshow and Aerospace & Defence Exposition at Avalon from 24 Feb - 01 Mar 2015. The work-up program will be conducted by 2OCU. **s47E(c)** (A FLTCDR 2OCU) will be the training instructor and will be conduct most of the supervision, including dual check rides. **s47E(c)** (HQACG), a previous display pilot, will supervise some simulator missions at RAAF Base Tindal.

3. s47E(c) will conduct a work-up for both the High Show and Low Show in preparation for Avalon 2015. The display sequences, training plan and display limits are contained in reference D. Authorisation of the work-up will be in accordance with the guidance contained at reference A and B.

4. Authorisation to conduct the flying display at Avalon will be sought from ACAUST closer to the event.

5. Due to the Williamtown TOFT being upgraded, the simulator missions for the work up will all be conducted in the RAAF Base Tindal TOFT. The workup flights will be conducted in the Tindal restricted airspace in consultation with 453SQN TN FLT, WLM Display Airspace and overhead WLM airfield.

AVALON 2015 HORNET FLYING DISPLAY WORK-UP PROGRAM

1. **Background.** These instructions describe the training requirements and procedures to be implemented by 2OCU in the execution of the 8WG Aerobatic Display workup for the Avalon Airshow 2015.

2. **Display Pilot.** The AF/A-18 pilot nominated to conduct the exercise is s47E(c) s22

3.Prior Training.\$47E(c)observed the process of the display execution by\$47E(c)for the Avalon Airshow 2011. He is a 2OCU instructor and is expectedto remain at the unit until at least 2016

4. The area designated to conduct low altitude (<4,000ft) work up sorties is the TDL airspace R249 and WLM Display Practice Airspace (WLM035-055R, 15-25TAC, up to FL200, feet dry). These areas are well clear of any built up or noise sensitive areas. Practice overhead Williamtown (5nm and up to F200) will be required to gain experience at judging crowd line distances and effects of crosswind.

5. To adequately prepare for the display, specific requirements concerning the location of crowd lines, local hazards, restrictions and foul lines will be required prior to the display date.

6. ATC liaison will be required to secure the airspace necessary to conduct the routine.

7. **Squadron resources.** A minimum of two aircraft will be required to deploy for the display venue at least one day prior to the first planned activity. This should allow suitable time for local orientation and airshow safety induction. One aircraft will be a spare while the other aircraft is used for the display.

8. **Aircraft configuration.** IAW reference D.

9. During training for the early on field practices special care needs to be taken to ensure that the aircraft is refuelled to only 8000lb. If the aircraft is inadvertently over-fuelled the aircraft will be defueled. If that is not available the alternative will be to takeoff, burn fuel within 5nm and setup for a straight in, low approach to commence the display. A T&G will not be available due to weight being above 33000lb.

10. **Display restrictions.** IAW reference D, annex B (restrictions change as the TMP progresses). All restrictions annotated conform to reference A and B, and subordinate instructions.

11. Weather Restrictions on Displays. IAW reference D.

12. **High Show to Low Show transition.** While the line for transitioning from High Show to Low Show is not always as clear as the numbers suggest, any doubt (especially in the initial workup phase) will result in a Low Show. Once experienced, the Display Pilot (in consultation with the authorising officer) will be capable of applying more discretion to this decision.

13. Where possible the High versus Low Show decision will be made prior to engine start in consultation with the authorising officer. If the weather is borderline for the High Show, the max performance takeoff planned in the display allows the pilot to safely assess the suitability of the weather and make a decision airborne. A Low Show will omit the looping manoeuvres and have all vertical repositions replaced with lateral repositions.

14. **Authorisation and Sortie Briefing.** CO 2OCU, XO 2OCU or ^{\$47E(c)}

will authorise flying display sorties. A thorough brief before all sorties will include items as listed in annex J to reference D (Briefing and Authorisation Guide). All sorties will be recorded (HUD-taped) and fully debriefed with authorising officer.

15. **Workup RMP.** Enclosure 1 includes only hazards and risks identified and controlled beyond those depicted in reference C.



Hi Sir,

Bringing you up to date on the air display plans for the Avalon Air Show to avoid surprises, and looking for your endorsement as to what we would like to do.

In December I briefed you that the flying committment broadly comprised:

Flying support to the trade days with an added emphasis to Wednesday when CAF will have many of his guests on site.

A one hour ADF Showcase on the Public Days of Friday Saturday and Sunday.

A number of individual displays on the Public days outside of the Showcase event.

At the FCP the flying program and supporting activities were developed as follows: (There has been some creep since which I have highlighted)

Friday - Media Day

Classic Hornet arrival and static display - pilot available for media interviews C17 practice handling display and land for media interviews (Slight change to FPC plan which was to have C17 conduct practice prior to media event and be on static only - I think that revised plan is better.) Both aircraft to RTB on completion.

Discussed at FPC but not proceeded with was for Hornet and C17 to conduct flypast over Melbourne CBD on departure. Subsequent rethink - C17 with Hornet on wing to conduct flyover of CBD on departure - to be coordinated with Public Affairs for maximum exposure. (36 are happy to do it and would initiate normal approval process) <u>Request your concurrence for persuing this addition.</u>

Saturday

C17 freights an Abrahams tank in from Adelaide. FYI

Tuesday - Opening Ceremony 1000hrs

Speeches finish with CAF thanking the speakers and 'introduces' brief flying demo with:

Pair of Supers conducting a Bomb and Strafe run with Pyros, followed immediately by Classic Hornet Aeros display.

Note: Pair of Supers are an addition to what was determined at the FPC - I have spoken to CAF on this and he would be happy for it to happen. <u>Request your concurrence that we proceed with this addition.</u>

ADF conducts practice activities in the 30 minute segment Ringmaster coordinating this activity with participants.






Frame 1 (Dive bomb and strafe attack profile)

Good Afternoon Sir, All,

I'm writing to provide the written factors around the contingency discussed with ^{s47E(c)} around refuelling the display Super Hornet in Coolangatta should weather or holding requirements prove restrictive to the planning assumptions/display fuel requirements.

To clarify, there would be no additional domestic costs incurred during this proposed option, it is simply a refuel stop to permit a full display when holding requirements exceed the fuel planning assumptions. There are no security overheads imposed with this option, any hard unserviceability experienced on the ground would be covered by extant 82WG diversion procedures.

The COAs that would drive to such an event are listed below, ultimately the aircraft can achieve ONSTA at the airshow in any conditions due to Amberley's proximity, but would be restricted in

what their performance would look like if weather (specifically at AMB) is a factor. If it is a desirable outcome for the RAAF to have the full handling display on each day, this represents a mechanism to minimise the risk to mission/display success.

Please let me know if you need any other information, we'll await any other formal guidance on this proposed option. Otherwise we don't expect this to be raised until a more accurate weather forecast is received closer to the event and actual planning factors are considered.

G'day Sir,

Thanks for the chat the other day exploring the option to land at the CG for the Pacific Airshow.

I briefly spoke to CO1 last week and he advised that he would be happy for us to explore the CG as a contingency if we need it.

s47E(c) and I ran some fuel numbers and we have come up with the following:

- We can achieve the full display AMB AMB with Instrument conditions at AMB
- We can't achieve the display AMB AMB with INTER / TEMPO at AMB.
- We have made an assumption that we will probably need to hold for approximately 10 mins prior to the display (as you are aware we have had no comms from the ringmaster yet to confirm exact holding time and location).

Are you able to assist with getting the ball rolling for us to land, gas and go from the CG? Only time this would be required is if there is INTER or TEMPO holding at AMB or we are required to hold longer than our assumptions.

As you are aware we would require a PCN concession. Our expected land weight would be around 40100 LBS and our tyre pressure is 290PSI.

Please let me know what other data you need.

Good afternoon HQAC Flypasts, \$47E(c)

Thank you for your time on the phone yesterday – I'm unsure how the additional request for support slipped through the formal processes, but greatly appreciate your time in chasing to ground what the proposal was.

Please note that ACG / the F/A-18F is <u>not</u> approved by AFHQ to conduct a flypast and static display ISO the PAGC Media Day on 14 Aug.

At this stage, we have fully expended the budget available to us under DACC policy (up to an key threshold) – so close in fact, that a small increase in estimated costs would require an escalation from CDF/MSC approval (which incidentally was staffed through in the previous few days for the AMG/F-35A swap), and require DPM approval. As we are a handful of days from the event, with existing approvals in place for our program from CAF and CDF, there is no appetite to contribute any additional assets to our robust Pacific Airshow Gold Coast 2024 roster.

Please note that this guidance relates to additional aircraft – I understand ACG personnel have been cleared as media spokespersons through the PA Plan, as has a Roulettes display; there are no concerns from AFHQ whatsoever with those engagements taking place.

I understand that this email is likely to be a disappointment to the team, but appreciate your understanding as we make sure RAAF participation in this event complies with extant DACC policy.
