

Why was the T1B Main Go Live deferred?

The Defence Committee deferred the release of the ERP Tranche 1B Main (T1B Main) Go Live from 7 October 2024 to allow for additional testing and assurance.

What is the revised T1B Main Go Live date?

The Defence Committee has endorsed the revised T1B Main Go Live of Q2 2025.

Has the T1B Main scope changed?

No, the scope of T1B Main has not changed. The deferred Go Live date allows for additional testing and assurance. T1B Main will provide an integrated finance, procurement, supply chain, land maintenance and engineering capability.

How can I find out who is my contract manager?

If you are unsure of who your contract manager is, please reach out to your Defence key contact.

Will contractors have access to the Defence ERP Practice Environment (sandpit) prior to Go Live?

Contract personnel who were role mapped for the October Go Live will be provided with access to a Defence ERP Practice Environment, based on their role assignment at that time.

Will there be an additional Role Mapping cycle?

Yes, a Delta Role Mapping cycle for T1B Main is being conducted by the Groups and Services together with the ERP Program. The Delta Role Mapping cycle aims to increase the accuracy of role mapping to date, including contractors.

What is the process for role-mapping / training for new starters?

The Delta Role Mapping cycle which is currently underway, aims to pick up any new starters so that they are mapped to the roles they require for their work and to ensure they are assigned their required training. There will also be work activities to capture “Joiners, Leavers & Movers” updates in February and March 2025.

How will Defence deliver training ahead of the revised Go Live date?

Personnel who have completed their assigned T1B Main training will not have to repeat it prior to the revised Go Live date. Any outstanding training will need to be completed in ADELE (P) prior to Go Live in order to be granted access to the ERP system on Day 1.

Additional refresher materials and opportunities to retain and enhance ERP knowledge will be offered from February 2025. These will include Micro Learning Sessions and ‘Do You Remember?’ Videos. Instructor Led classroom training will be provided where user volume dictates, and where trainer availability exists.

Will MILIS training be available between now and Go Live?

Yes, MILIS training can be requested and will continue to be available in the lead up to the revised T1B Main Go Live. Please speak to your Defence key contact regarding requirements or go through your current MILIS training channels.

Where can we sign up to the SAP Business Network?

The timing of onboarding to the SAP Business Network is dependent on the type of account you will have. Onboarding for those with Standard accounts will commence from Go Live – once the first purchase order is received. For Enterprise accounts, the process has commenced and will need to be completed prior to Go Live.
