- ✓ Drive alignment and standardisation across Defence, making it simpler for Defence Industry to engage with Defence and support capability across different areas.
- ✓ Remove ageing and disparate systems, which will simplify tools and processes used by both Defence and many of Defence's industry partners.
- ✓ Introduce the SAP Business Network for Procurement, providing near real-time status updates – facilitating greater efficiency, visibility and transparency for materials management across the order cycle.
- ✓ Provide improved quality of real-time data within Defence, making it easier for Defence Industry to access the data they need to make better informed decisions, and to support more accurate capability planning and workforce management.
