

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QUESTION: What is the government doing about military exports to Israel?

KEY TALKING POINTS:

- Australia maintains a robust and thorough export control regime, which requires each application to be assessed on its merits in accordance with Australian export control legislation.
 - This legislation addresses a range of issues including foreign policy, human rights, national security, regional security and Australia's international obligations. This includes Australia's obligations to regulate conventional arms and its components under the Arms Trade Treaty.
 - A permit would be refused if there were an overriding risk that an export would be used contrary to Australia's national interest, including violating human rights.
 - Australia's export control regime is administered by the Department of Defence which grants permits according to strict legislative criteria.
 - The Australian Border Force administers exports controls and has relevant powers to ensure the movements of goods occur in accordance with the *Customs Act 1901*.
-
- The Australian Border Force is responsible for administering imports and exports under the *Customs Act 1901* and subordinate regulations.
 - Administering imports and exports can be complex work, with goods requiring permission typically having a permit issued by the relevant Commonwealth regulatory agency.
 - For example, the Department of Defence is responsible for issuing export permits for military and dual-use goods and technology listed on the Defence and Strategic Goods List.
 - The Australian Border Force has dedicated functions that work across government to actively monitor threats to the border posed by a range of goods including military grade and dual-use items.
 - These functions assess risk and enforce decisions made by Commonwealth regulators including ensuring export permits are valid and holding malign actors to account through criminal investigations.

If asked: How many exports have occurred to Israel since 7 October 2023?

- Australia maintains a case-by-case approach under its export controls framework, which enables legitimate trade and mitigates the risk of inadvertently preventing exports that are in Australia's national interest, such as those supporting Australian Defence Force's capability.
- If Australia identified an export would be used contrary to the national interest, including violating human rights, a permit would be refused.
- Permits should not be conflated with weapons. Permits are required for a broad range of goods and technologies, many of which have legitimate commercial and civilian applications.
- Due to legal, privacy and commercial-in-confidence obligations I will not comment on individual exports.

BACKGROUND AND CHRONOLOGY

15 April 2024: [The Guardian](#) uploaded a 6 minute video that shows: political debate in Parliament, including The Green's questioning Australia exporting weapons to Israel; the government defending the process in Parliament and Senate Estimates; exploring the legal definition of weapons and the contract awarded to Elbit Systems (an Israeli company) from Hanwha Defense Australia for work on the Redback Infantry Fighting Vehicle.

9 April 2024: [The Sydney Morning Herald](#) published an article outlining countries export of defence materiel to Israel, including exports sent by Australia, explaining the United Nations definition of what a weapon is, and what the potential options are for the government in relation to banning exports.

28 March 2024: [Al Jazeera](#) published an article on linking defence exports to Israel to the government's ambition to become a defence industry leader, and analysis by international law experts on the governments obligations.

9 February 2024: Minister Pat Conroy said in an ABC Radio Interview – All I can say to you is we're not exporting weapons to Israel. There's a system that deals with applications for every country that seeks to buy military weapons from Australia that requires permission from the Department of Defence. But what I can say to you is that we are not exporting weapons to Israel. That's a factual statement.
