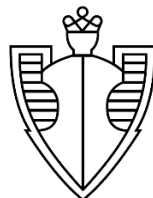
The King's Cup

In 1919, military crews raced at the Royal Henley Peace Regatta for a prize donated by King George V, The King's Cup. Alongside Allies and whilst recovering from World War I, these men served their nations to help build the peace.

In 2019, in front of 100,000 spectators, Allied Chiefs and Ministers of Defence, the King's Cup event at Henley Royal Regatta was a mixed gender military race between military crews from the United Kingdom, USA, France, Canada, Germany, Australia, New Zealand and the Netherlands.

Military crews will race again for The King's Cup,
honouring the past,
celebrating the role of women in defence,
promoting the enduring impact of sports,
and forging firm allies from former foes.

Prizes were approved by Queen Elizabeth II and incorporated precious gifts including original brass from 1798 President Washington's first battleship; four Croix de Guerre posthumously awarded to French soldiers who died alongside Allies in WWI; New Zealand military metal from every campaign they have ever fought; silver from King George V's original gift, and precious metal from the Royal Mausoleum overlooking the River Thames.

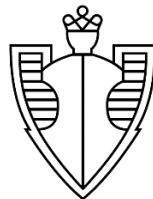
Optional programme – the (NLD) Army Regatta
