Navy officials, including Head Navy Capability, met with Elbit Systems of Australia representatives and visited their stand during Indo Pacific 2023 International Maritime Exposition.

In February 2024, Elbit announced that it has been awarded a contract worth approximately USD600 million to supply systems to Hanwha Defense Australia for Land 400 Phase 3. This project aims to deliver advanced protection, fighting capabilities and sensors suite to the Redback Infantry Fighting Vehicles for the Australian Army. The contract will be performed over a period of five years.

If asked: Is Defence in contract with Elbit Systems?

- · Hanwha Defense Australia has awarded a contract to Elbit Systems Limited to manufacture the turret for the Redback Infantry Fighting Vehicle under LAND 400 Phase 3.
- Defence has no direct commercial relationship with Elbit Systems Limited or Elbit Land Systems Australia under LAND 400 Phase 3. All engagements regarding the LAND 400 Phase 3 contract are through Hanwha Defense Australia as the contracting entity.

<i>If</i>	asked: Will Defence be exporting Elbit items to Israel? Turrets made under this contract are for use by the Australian Army. \$33(a) (iii)
th	asked: Does Defence hold security concerns about Elbit software related to e Infantry Fighting Vehicle?
