The FPAP (AE679) is to be completed and returned with OC signature to \$47E(d) @defence.gov.au no later than one week prior to the event. This timeframe facilitates release of Media Alerts and ACAUST briefings.

Instructions:

- 1. The FPAP is to be initiated by the HQAC Flypasts desk officer in consultation with AFHQ and forwarded to FEG Plans via email. An FPAP may also be raised by a subordinate planning agency. When raised by a subordinate planning agency, @defence.gov.au is to be a CC when sending the form to FEG Plans.
- FEG Plans are to complete the second section of the form and forward to the approval authority detailed in AC SI(OPS) 03-08 Flypasts and Flying Displays.
- 3. The FEG planning agency is to retain ownership of the progress of the FPAP, passing it to the approval authority, the Unit then the Wing OC, until it is completed and returned to HQAC.
- 4. For events authorised by a separate approval mechanism (eg. HPPE, PR Assets Calendar, TASKORD, EXINST, standing authorisation minute), the "Authority to Conduct Flypast / Display" should be signed by FEG Plans. In these cases the approval mechanism is to be included in the Objective Reference Documents link.
- 5. For events that require ACAUST approval, FEG Plans are to email the FPAP back to \$47E(d) @defence.gov.au for processing.
- 6. The aircraft captain (or delegate) is to complete the Flypast / Display profile details. The intended profile is to be co-ordinated with the event organisers and the FEG Public Affairs Officer.
- 7. The Wing OC, as the platform airworthiness SME, is to authorise the Flypast / Display profile and email the completed AE679 tos47E(d) @defence.gov.au.
- 8. The HQAC Flypast desk officer s47E(d) @defence.gov.au) and HQAC Military Public Affairs @defence.gov.au) are to be advised as soon as practical should the requested Flypast / Display require changes or be cancelled.
