Thanks, please see the updated documents and an email between the Flying Display Supervisor and the ^{s47G} [redacted] representative.

I have adjusted the requested time to 1630-1800 Local (0530-0700z) with the intent to have Sy ATC control and provide a time on target with max window of 10min to allow for the guest to stop and speak to people.

We are solution agnostic as far as the level being up to base of CTA (and AsA control above within the map) or to the A080 based upon AsA preference. There will be a number of RW low level, below A010 and then up to four RAAF fast jet for the flypast.

We can clarify within the AIP SUP and NOTAM the timings and levels as long as they are bounded within the approved lateral and temporal dimensions approved by CASA.
