## Defence Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) Tranche 1B Main (T1B Main)

- The Defence ERP Program T1B Main release will Go Live on Monday 12 May 2025.
- T1B Main introduces critical capabilities in logistics, engineering, maintenance, procurement and financial management, replacing multiple outdated and siloed legacy systems.
- Defence is seeking the support of our Industry Partners to engage ERP readiness activities to ensure a smooth transition to ERP.
- Industry readiness activities include:
  - Completion of all assigned training by 2 May 2025.
  - Preparation for system freeze activities, including applicable downtime procedures.
  - Understanding potential impacts on invoice and delivery timelines.
  - Familiarity of the support options available to you during the HyperCare period.
- We encourage you to engage with your Defence key contact and fully participate in these readiness activities.

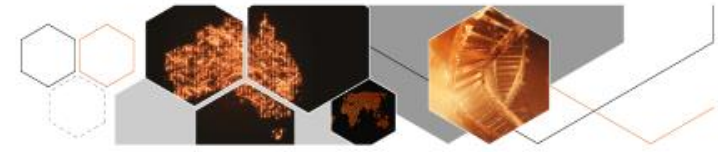


## Ramp Down Period

**We are currently in the Ramp Down Period** which focuses on preparing Defence for the transition to the new ERP system. This phase will run **until 30 April 2025**.

During this phase industry partners using Defence systems may be asked to:

- Complete data remediation and cleansing activities in legacy systems.
- Finalise non-critical tasks.
- Prepare systems and people for the freeze.
- Limit system changes (configuration or code change) to essential changes only.

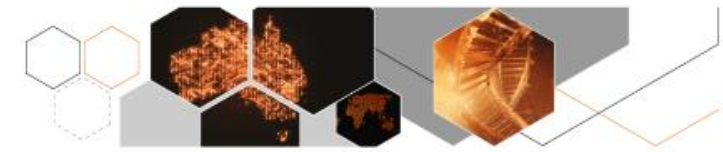


## T1B Main Training

- **The T1B Main training window is now open.** All assigned training must be **completed by Friday, 2 May 2025** in order to be granted access to the system on Day 1.
- Training is being delivered as:
  - Self-paced eLearning
  - In-person Instructor-Led Training (ILT) (scheduled for 17 March – 2 May)
- **Review, Refresh and Rehearse** mechanisms are also available to allow users to practise the ERP skills they have learned. These include:
  - ‘Do You Remember’ videos
  - ERP Practice Environment
  - Micro Learning sessions at select ERP On the Road locations
- All ERP training is in **ADELE (P)**, accessible only from inside the Defence Protected Network (DPN).

**Access to ERP is dependent on the successful completion of required training.**

**No training, no access, and no partial access.**



## Get Set for System Freeze

The System Freeze Period is a controlled and critical phase where legacy system transactions are suspended to enable the safe migration of data and technical transition to ERP (SAP S/4HANA platform). This phase will run from **01 May to 12 May 2025**.

During this phase, industry partners using Defence systems must:

- Cease all transactions (those systems listed will be put into Read Only mode, or login restricted).
- Follow any applicable downtime (interim) processes outlined to perform critical business processes
  - Links to these processes, templates or instructions are detailed on the T1B Main Go Live Portal.
- Record all data/transactions manually.
- Complete all end user training.

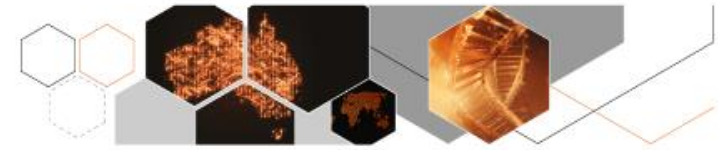

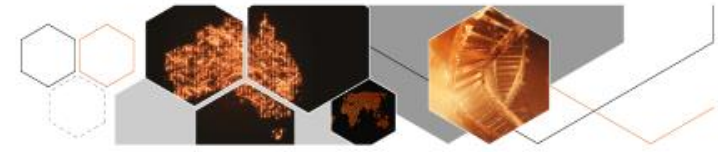


## Key Invoicing and Delivery Timelines

To minimise disruption during the System Freeze phase, please take note of the following key dates:

<b>Invoicing</b> Any invoices submitted after these dates will be processed after Go Live	Submit <b>email invoices</b> to <a href="mailto:invoices@defence.gov.au">invoices@defence.gov.au</a>	No later than 1700 hours 22 April 2025
	Submit <b>eInvoices</b> through MILIS DESE / Webview or PEPPOLE	No later than 1700 hours 28 April 2025
	Resume sending invoices to Defence using existing channels. Reminder that quoting Defence's 10-digit Purchase Order number on all Tax Invoices is <b>mandatory</b>  Note: <b>eInvoices</b> against open MILIS Purchase Orders will need to be submitted as email invoices to <a href="mailto:invoices@defence.gov.au">invoices@defence.gov.au</a> due to the closure of MILIS DESE/Webview. eInvoices through the SAP Business Network will only be available for new Purchase Orders, not open MILIS Purchase Orders.	12 May 2025
<b>Deliveries</b> Non-warehouse deliveries to Defence addresses will continue as normal	Contact your Defence Key Contact / Purchase Order Point of Contact to reschedule any deliveries to a <b>Joint Logistic Unit (JLU) warehouse</b> during this period	17 April – 12 May 2025

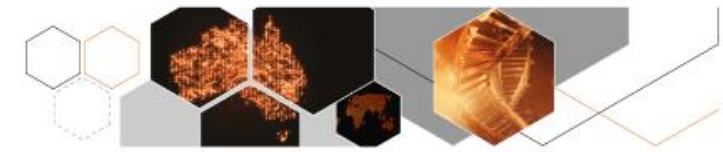
## Ramp Up Activities From Go Live

The Ramp Up Period will transition Defence into full operational use of T1B Main solution. This phase will commence from Go Live on **12 May 2025**.

Industry partners using Defence systems will need to carry out the following activities:

- Update ERP with all manually recorded transactional data captured during the System Freeze period.
- Execute the agreed post Go Live data load activities.
- Gradually resume BAU operations.
- Utilise HyperCare and support options.



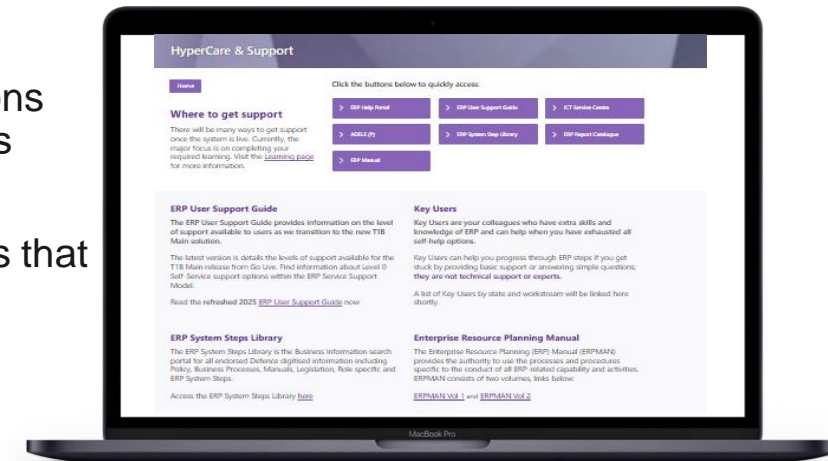


## Support at Go Live

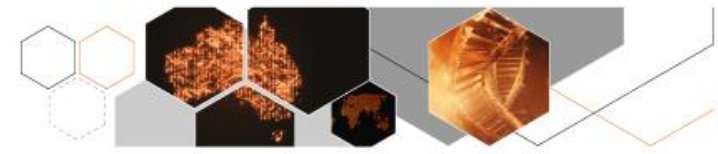
From Go Live, Defence will enter a 3-month HyperCare period of heightened support for ERP users, running until 12 August 2025.

Support will include:

- **ERP User Support Guide** – The ERP User Support Guide provides information on the various levels of support available to ERP users.
- **Onsite Support** – Onsite Support will provide ERP end users at selected defence locations with face-to-face support for the first 4 weeks post Go Live. The aim is to ensure business continuity, ramp up activities are completed and L0 support options are reinforced.
- **Key Users** – Help their colleagues to help themselves using the available ERP resources that form part of the Level 0 Self Service Support, and provide support by answering basic questions.
- **ERP Help Portal** – Provides access to ERP reference guides, system simulations and eLearning support materials.
- **ERP System Steps Library** – The ERP System Steps Library is the Business Information search portal for all endorsed Defence digitised information including Policy, Business Processes, Manuals, Legislation, Role specific and ERP System Steps.
- **Enterprise Resource Planning Manual** – The Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) Manual (ERPMAN) provides the authority to use the processes and procedures specific to the conduct of all ERP-related capability and activities.

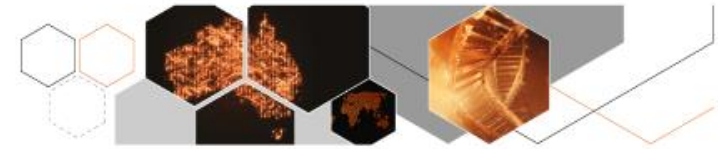
