#### **Executive Summary**

JNT 8190 Phase 1 (Support) is the provision of support services for the Deployable Bulk Fuel Distribution System, to the Commonwealth of Australia (CoA). WFS-A is the Contractor delivering the capability to the CoA, supported by its Australian industry partners. The primary elements of the program that will be conducted in Australia include:

- a. Support Services Management;
- b. Operating Support;
- c. Project Management;
- d. Engineering Support;
- e. Maintenance Support;
- f. Supply Support;
- g. Training Support;
- h. Support Environment;
- i. Quality Management; and
- j. Health, Safety and Environment.

The duration of the JNT 8190 Phase 1 Contract (Support) is five (5) years. The Australia Contract Expenditure value per annum is \$5.7M, with the Australia Industry Activity value being \$4M.

There are no CoA identified Sovereign Industrial Capability Priorities associated with this contract.
